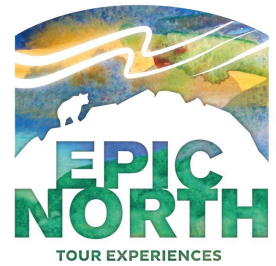

Introducing Our Exclusive Aurora Experience: Unrivalled Views, Unmatched Comfort

Located in a quiet forest setting just 20 minutes from Whitehorse, our purpose-built Aurora Lounge offers a more refined and comfortable approach to northern lights viewing. Designed specifically for the conditions of the Yukon, the experience allows guests to enjoy the aurora without the typical challenges of cold temperatures and long periods spent outdoors.

Inside, the space features lounge style seating, a central fireplace, and large north facing windows, allowing guests to view the aurora from indoors if they prefer. Adjustable lighting ensures optimal visibility while maintaining a relaxed atmosphere throughout the evening. Outside, a spacious viewing area provides clear, unobstructed access to the night sky.

Guests are welcomed into a small, intimate group each night, creating a calm and unhurried environment. A licensed bar offers a selection of local beers and BC wines, along with light snacks and hot drinks, allowing guests to settle in and enjoy the evening at their own pace.

Throughout the experience, guides provide clear insights into the aurora and are available to assist with photography, ensuring guests make the most of the conditions.

The program includes hotel pick-up in downtown Whitehorse at approximately 10:00 PM, a short transfer to the viewing location, and return around 2:00 AM, with flexibility depending on aurora activity.

Aurora Viewing Weekend Break Package

This multi-day winter package is designed for travellers seeking a well-organised introduction to the Yukon, combining northern lights viewing with key winter activities in a comfortable and accessible format.

Based in Whitehorse, guests stay at the Hyatt Place, providing a consistent level of comfort and central location throughout the program. The itinerary is paced to balance daytime experiences with late-night aurora viewing, allowing guests time to rest and enjoy each activity without feeling rushed.

The program includes a guided tour to the Yukon Wildlife Preserve and Eclipse Nordic Hot Springs, offering a combination of wildlife viewing and relaxation in a natural setting. A half-day dog sledding experience is also included, providing an introduction to one of the Yukon's most iconic winter activities.

Northern lights viewing is centred around our purpose-built Aurora Lounge, located in a dark-sky setting just outside the city. The experience is designed to provide a more comfortable alternative to traditional aurora tours, with access to a heated indoor space, outdoor viewing area, and hosted environment.

This package is well suited to travellers looking for a structured, small-group winter experience that combines key Yukon highlights with reliable delivery and a higher level of comfort.

Designed as an ideal short Yukon winter escape, this package works well as a standalone long weekend or as an extension to a broader Canadian itinerary, such as Whistler or Banff. Scheduled departures typically run from Friday to Monday, with the option to add an additional night from Thursday. Alternative dates can also be arranged on request, providing flexibility for clients travelling outside of standard departure windows.

Please note: Airport transfers are only available for flights departing between 9am and 9pm. For flights outside of those hours, guests will need to use the hotel's free airport shuttle
